

Strategic Writing Across the Curriculum in Grades 7-12

Writing is an enabling skill that has a direct impact on academic proficiency and success beyond the classroom. To bring students up to speed, schools must implement schoolwide programs in writing to improve students' fluency and organization as well as their skills in writing for different purposes and audiences.

Strategic Writing Across the Curriculum in Grades 7-12 emphasizes the need for writing in all content areas. Not only should writing occur in every classroom, but also writing should become a major component of the school culture. 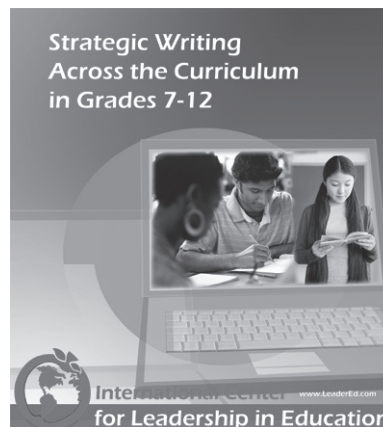

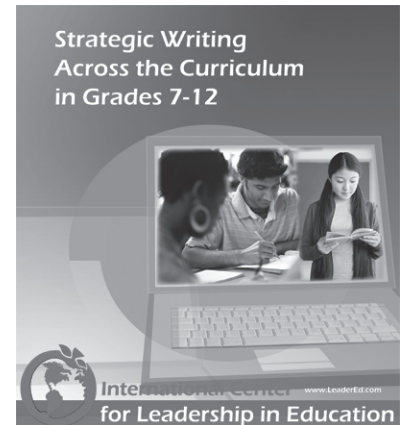
